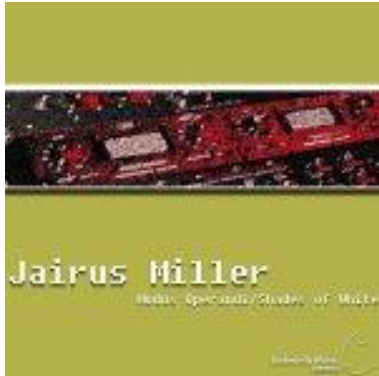

OVERVIEW

Jairus Miller has been making noise of some sort ever since he was a child. After taking piano lessons intermittently, he picked up a guitar at age 13 and began to make new kinds of noises. The desire to expand his spectrum of musical expression eventually materialized in the recording of sounds on tape, and this turn led to the acquisition and use of software-based, computer music production.

In 1998, Jairus first began releasing music online under the moniker "Isotope 99", and later under the guise of "5i". Soon after, Jairus's music found its way into a variety of production music libraries, for use in film, television, and other media. In 2004 Jairus had his first digital music release - the four-track "Feng Shui" EP, which received support from many internationally-known DJs.

Since then Jairus has slowly developed and grown artistically over time, and in the past few years his music has been featured in DJ sets and mixes, compilations, national television broadcasts, live online webcasts, and a variety of music reviews.

Fresh from his appearance on **Nick Warren's** brand new **Global Underground** compilation with the track **Botnet**, Jairus Miller brings 2 breathtaking new tracks to Underbelly Music.

Modus Operandi is deep and melodic and guaranteed to bring you to your knees, while Shades of White is driving peak time melodic progressive at its finest, and is sure to be a feature on dance floors across the globe.

"Jairus Miller is an artist who has been appearing on various labels like Pure Substance Records, Source of Gravity, and Adjust Recordings over the last few years. A recent high moment was the inclusion of "Bonet" on Nick Warren's Global Underground CD.

The Miller sound is comprised of driving basslines, abstract melodies, and distinct layered soundscapes. The newly formed Underbelly Music imprint brings us their next installment via this 2 track EP.

Modus Operandi is the opening track of the EP. This is a lovely soundscape progressive moment with shinning chords and melodies fully on display. A neat rolling bassline brings an element of stability to proceedings, definitely a fine start to the EP.

On the flip side, "Modus Operandi" has partner in crime in the form of Shades of White. This track is perhaps more energetic than the former, but those spectacular arpeggio patterns and soaring melodies still come to the fore regardless, another top quality track for sure.

For the second release on Underbelly Music, this definitely should attract some favourable support and publicity for the fledgling imprint. In terms of the artist, this should solidify his position as one of the more exciting progressive artists at the moment."
